Main Street & George Street will be swept on April 9, 2018, beginning at 8:00 AM. Please sweep stones and debris from your sidewalk before the sweeper passes and kindly park off the street. Additionally, street sweeping will occur on April 10, 2018, beginning at 8:00 AM in Sherwood Forest. Please make sure you remove your car from the designated streets.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE VIOLATIONS

As the weather gets warmer, please remember to maintain exterior property areas. The majority of code violations are a result of overgrown grass and vegetation, accumulation of junk and debris, and unlicensed or junked vehicles. Borough Officials will continue to send violation notices and if the violation is not remedied within the allotted time frame, fines will be issued. Fines can range from \$100 to \$1,000 per day per violation.

REMINDER TO CLEAR LEAVES FROM DRAINAGE SYSTEM CATCH BASINS

Our municipal storm drainage system is designed to handle heavy rain events, however catch basins can become covered with leaves and other debris. When this occurs, stormwater runoff into our drainage system may be slowed, or even blocked.

Residents are reminded to be aware of this and asked to please be proactive in keeping catch basins free and clear of any leaves or debris. A quick sweep with a broom or rake will easily clear a catch basin and keep our drainage systems flowing properly.

In addition, if you see the drainage system is not working properly after clearing the catch basin grates, there may be an issue below the surface. If you feel that this has occurred, please contact New Salem Borough at info@newsalemborough.com or 717-739-6053.



CURB AND SIDEWALK PROJECTS PLANNED

The Borough has been awarded \$200,000 in grant funds under the Community Development Block Grant program administered by the York County Planning Commission. These funds will be used to extend sidewalk and curbing along West George Street, allowing for safe pedestrian travel from the square to Friar Road. This project will span 2018 and 2019 and involve cooperation between property owners, PennDOT, Borough staff, council, engineer, and a contractor to be chosen at a later date. More information will be relayed to residents as the project moves forward.
