OPEN BURNING REGULATIONS

As warmer weather approaches and outdoor gatherings increase, please remember the guidelines regarding open burning.

- ❖ Open fires shall be permitted only on the second Saturday of each month between the hours of 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Open fires on these dates are subject to cancellation if a burn ban is issued.
- ❖ Recreational fires for pleasure, religious, ceremonial, cooking, warmth or similar purposes, which are in an outdoor fireplace, barbecue grill, barbecue pit, chimenea, or other container or fire rings that do not exceed three feet in diameter and is located at least fifteen (15) feet from any building are permitted.
